Below is my earlier response to your previous email. My email bounced back. The email address was incorrect.

In response to your email:

1. There is no public participation for renewal of state permit to operate, therefore notices are not publish.
2. Public notices are published when a facility applies for a permit to construct for equipment/process that requires public participation. COMAR 26.11.02.13 list equipment/process that requires public participation.
3. With regards to "TRI" emissions: Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) Program, annually certain industrial facilities report data to EPA. This is an EPA program. TRI inquires or complaints are not handled by MDE. MDE verifies company's submittal to TRI database.
